

#### **How it started**



#### First steps

Question-driven → list open questions, prioritize and formed 5 subteams

**Subteams work independently at their own pace** 

Each subteam includes one of WG leads



## **Challenges**

Different levels of estimand understanding

Clarity how the work of the subteams fits together

**Exchange between subteams** 

**Onboarding new members** 



#### **Second phase**

10 task forces, most without WG leads

Many more people take the lead and initiative

**Connections between subteams and members established** 

**Connections with other organisations** 



# One example of evolution: External communication

#### First phase: coordinated by WG leads

- Connect subteams with conference and session proposals
- Use global footprint with members in US, EU and Asia
- Be fair to all subteams
- Reward the doers

## Second phase: much less involvement by WG leads

- Members comfortable organizing themselves
- Task force on external engagement

#### How it ends

Work in many task forces completed

Ongoing work does not require the construct of the WG

Found a new home for ongoing activities – e.g. PRO task force spun off as a new SIG
